The Problem

Project and programme leaders often learn and make mistakes in a live environment, which is costly and can be career limiting. They learn the hard skills of managing the project programme but the soft skills of consulting, 'selling' solutions and managing expectations are neglected in typical training.

The life cycle of major projects is often measured in months or even years, with the 'lessons learnt' piece coming at the end (if at all), when it is too late to be useful. Here the delegates are building reflective and analytical skills, as well as soft skills, which will make them better able to build in continuous improvement and nip any emerging problems in the bud.

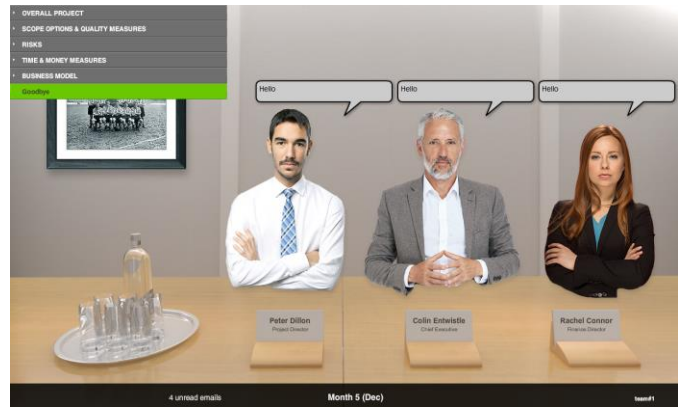
The Simulation is ideal for any consultant or manager for whom influence, consultation and building consensus are highly important for getting things done. Excellent for:

What's It All About?

Typically run over two days or 4x4 hour Virtual Sessions, this blend of a six to eight hour simulation with learning sessions brings to life the theory behind project leadership. The simulation is played in four parts, with a de-brief and a focus on strategy and re-planning in-between. Teams of three people go through the simulation together, undertaking different roles and collaborating to ensure the team's success.



Why Attend?

- Project leadership gives you the techniques to lead your immediate team members and influence your wider stakeholders.
- Provides valuable experience in team leadership and building consensus over decisions – both in the simulation and in your team.
- Project Leadership skills increase a leader's confidence as they underline what the team members are doing right (with immediate feedback) as well as giving valuable feedback on those areas that need further development.
- It provides best practice terms of reference to those project leaders who are self taught or have learned on the job.

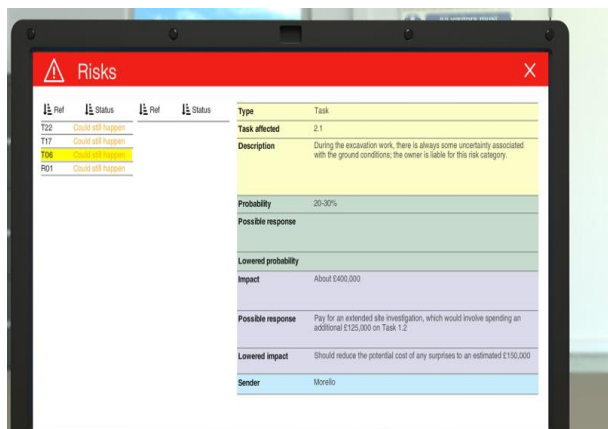
What do I need to run this?
